Trust Objectives

The trustees of The Mylne Trust are enabled, under the scheme of regulation, to distribute funds for the benefit of such persons of either sex who are or have been engaged in evangelistic work including retired missionaries or missionaries still engaged as such or continuing Christian workers of any description as the trustees, in their absolute discretion shall from time to time select but so that no person shall be eligible for any benefit under this charity unless he or she shall be a Protestant in religion and a wholehearted believer in the deity of Christ and the full inspiration of scripture.

***Some General Guidance**

Please note the following:

- The trustees like to see that applicants are applying to other sources for grants. Declaring this will not prejudice your chances of receiving a grant from the Mylne Trust. Stating the names of other trusts etc that have already approved grants for you will be viewed positively by the Mylne Trust.
- Fees etc can be listed as part of your living expenses.
- Trustees like to receive the third party references indicated below from persons who know you and can confirm your aptitude and suitability for the study or activity you are planning. The referees should be people well placed to make such judgements and you should ask referees to state within the letter their position and qualifications, how long they have known you and the background to knowing you (referees must not be related to you).

Required Documents

When the entire form has been duly completed, print it out and sign it in both of the required places. Then please attach the following (we require all of these items before an application can be considered):

1. At least one letter of support from your home church or other appropriate Christian body. Such letters must be signed by a person who has known you for a reasonable time but is not related to you. Letters should be on printed letterhead and come from a senior full-time pastor or official who can attest to your commitment and personal qualities, indicating the way in which they think both you and your Christian work will benefit from the intended course or project. If possible, the referee should give contact details to enable the trustees, if they so wish, to follow up by emailing, writing or telephoning.
2. If you are a prospective student, please send evidence that you have been accepted for a course of study at your college. If you are already a student, please send a letter of support from your college tutor or principal which includes an appraisal of your progress so far.

(If you are not a student or ordinand and you are applying for assistance in connection with some other kind of evangelistic project or activity, please send supporting documents from appropriate third parties that confirm to the trustees the nature of the activity you will be undertaking and include evaluations of your abilities and suitability for the activity.)

3. A passport-size (or larger) photograph of yourself certified on the reverse by the same college tutor or principal, or the minister of your home church, that it is a true likeness
